Educational Volunteer Opportunity

- Adults with teaching experience or medical background are needed to help present an educational program called *My Blood, Your Blood*® to 5th grade students in Sarasota and DeSoto Counties. This program teaches students about the importance of the circulatory system and the lifesaving role of blood. The position will require making classroom presentations, organizational skills and some light travel around the area.

As an added perk, the Blood Bank is a member of the SHARE Program, which rewards volunteerism with great food discounts. Someone who volunteers two hours per month qualifies for name brand food products up to 50% off the store price. Qualification is not need based.
