How you become eligible to apply:

Donate blood three or more times and/or/combination

Volunteer a minimum of 30 hours for SunCoast Blood Centers beginning the summer going into your senior year

About the SCBB Scholarship Program

- High School students in Charlotte, DeSoto, Manatee, and Sarasota counties are eligible to earn scholarship funds from SunCoast Blood Centers through donations of blood and/or volunteer hours with SCBC*
- In order to apply for a scholarship, applicants MUST meet the Student Eligibility Requirements

Student Eligibility Requirements:

A student must demonstrate support of SCBC by doing one or more or a combination of the following:

- Donate blood three or more times their senior year with SCBC beginning summer going into senior year
- Volunteer a minimum of 30 hours their senior year with SCBC beginning summer going into senior year
- Applicants must graduate during the current scholarship cycle with a 2.5 GPA or higher

Scholarship Selection Process:

- Scholarship funds are calculated based on a standard point system which includes number of blood donations, number of volunteer hours, essay questions, and teacher/administrator recommendation.
- <u>STUDENTS MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION</u> which will be reviewed by a committee comprised of blood bank employees, board of directors, and community leaders.

Note: Scholarships are not guaranteed for each student.

Applicants must submit:

- Completed application form, with essays
- Most recent report card (copies will be accepted) or proof of Graduating 2021
- Volunteer confirmation form if you served volunteer hours at SCBC
